**Remarks:**

Folio format. Folios numbered recently in pencil. Starting on 10<sup>th</sup> folio, pagination appears with pp. 47-53, then only sporadically: 54 (f. 15r), 55 (f. 26r). 1 folio missing at beginning. This print appears to be a compilation of other printed works: *Missa Sine Nomine* from *Partitura del Terzo Libro della Messa Sine Nomine* (RISM A416), also in *Missarum liber Posthumus* (RISM A419); *Missa Benedicam Dominum* and motet *Benedicam Dominum* from *Spartitura della Messa et Motetto Benedicam Dominum* (RISM A417, SD 1627<sup>3</sup>, N25); *Missa Quatuor vocibus pro vigilijs, ac Ferijs* from *Spartitura delle Messe del Primo Libro* (RISM A413, also in *Partitura delle messe, et motetti*); *Missa Gaudeamus, Gaudeamus omnes in Domino* and *Adoramus te Christe* (motets) from *Partitura delle messe, et motetti* (RISM A418). The last two items do not appear elsewhere. At bottom of f. 13v: *Quinta pars adjunctu fi placet, à Paulo Augustino Laus Deo.*”, then follows: “*Declaratium Notarum in Ligatura. Io. Maria Nanini*” for the antiphon *Venite filij*. 5<sup>th</sup> part of Nanini’s antiphon evidently added by Agostini. In *Missa ad Canones*: Red ink for some titles and for text of Benedictus (ff. 26r-v. On f. 26v.: “*Credo 4 Vocum ad Canones. Ubi verba sunt duplicata B. cum T. cantant verba inferiora, Alt. autem cum Canto superiora.*” In *Missa Septimi Toni ad Canones*: “*Ubi verba sunt duplicata, Partes graves canunt inferiora, acute vero superiora.*” (ff. 27r-v.)
