Remarks:

Quarto format. Requiem mass first printed in 1614 collection (RISM A1110). Tract is in chant notation in all parts. Sequence sets every other verse polyphonically; other verses are in chant notation in Canto, Alto, and Bassus parts, along with intonations for other portions of the mass.
