**Remarks:**

Quarto format. Intonations in Tenor part-book. Cantus part-book indicates *Nisi Dominus* as “Septimi Toni,” but rubric is hand-corrected to “Octavi.” Bassus part-book indicates *Credidi* as “Octau Toni,” but is hand-corrected to “Sexti to.” *De profundis* is indicated as “Quinti Toni” in index only. Copy consulted: I-PCd. RISM V1334. Later editions of 1595 (RISM V1335), 1597 (RISM V1336), 1601 (RISM V1337), 1609 (RISM V1338), Frankfurt edition of 1610 (RISM V1339) and Italian edition of 1611 (RISM V1340). All later editions omit *Cantate Domino* but add a set of falsibordoni in all nine tones. 1595 edition substitutes a *Magnificat octo vocum* for *Cantate Domino*. 1609 and 1611 editions add a Bassus pro Organo part-book.
